With reference to the subject cited above, a copy of the communication received from the Joint Secretary, MoRTH, New Delhi is forwarded for pursuance. In this regard, it is hereby instructed the Licencing and Asst. Licencing Authorities of U.T of Puducherry, that the application for grant of Driving Licence for Non Commercial cars and motor cycles under Sec. 8(4) of MV Act, 1988, for the person having monocular vision may be considered subject to the following conditions.

- a) Visual acuity in the remaining or the better eye is 6/12 or better.
- b) Horizontal visual field is 120 degrees or more on Golman perimetry/
Confrontation test.
- c) Sufficient time (6 months) has been allowed after the loss of eye /
vision/ in other eye for the person to adapt to loss of same.

The Licencing authorities and Asst. Licencing authorites are also hereby instructed to refer the applicant to the Medical Board , Health Department, Puducherry to obtain a certificate in this regard ~~from~~ for granting of such driving licence.
